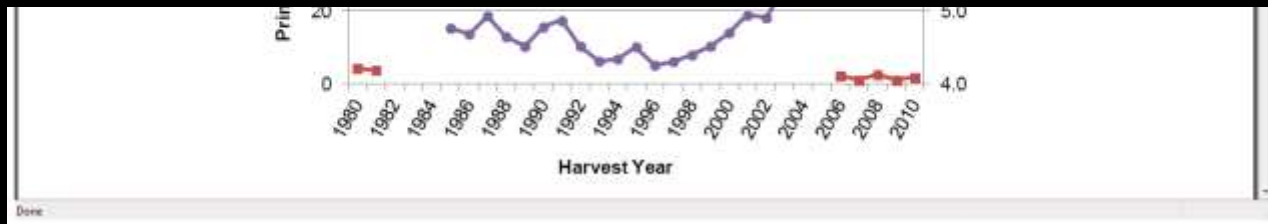




# UK figures: HGCA Report 502 (2011)
